First International Multi-stakeholder Symposium on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture

Technical Consultation on *In Situ* Conservation and On-Farm Management of PGRFA

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), the International Treaty for Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture and the Global Crop Diversity Trust are co-organizing a two-day Symposium that will bring together technical experts and stakeholders working on plant genetic resources for food and agriculture (PGRFA) conservation and use. The symposium aims to foster synergies and highlight the current state of knowledge and the enabling environment for *in situ* conservation and on-farm management of PGRFA.
